Meals, Tiffin, Tea, Snacks, Bed and Bedding, Dresses, Bathing soap, Hair Oil are being provided to the Old Age People in the Old Age Home. The activities includes gainful economic activities, discussions, discourses, adult education, Medical education, games, Outings etc.,

The Old Age Home is having adequate accommodation as per the Government instructions. Proper Seating arrangements have been provided. One doctor (part time) has been appointed and he is visiting the Old Age Home, 8 times per month. As per the doctor advice medicines are being purchasing and given to the Old Age People.

World Elders Day Celebration

The World elders Day Celebration for the year 2021 was celebrated on 01.10.2021 in Bharathamatha Thaiveedu Old Age Home, Ettukudi at 11.00 a.m.

The District Collector of Nagapattinam, Thiru.A.Arun Thampuraj I.A.S., Has presided over the function. A Free Medical Camp was conducted on this occasion. The Senior Citizens and Old Age Persons were given free medicines and Spectacles. Various Sports Competitions were conducted to the Old Age Persons. The District Collector of Nagapattinam has distributes the prizes to the winners. In addition to that New Dress materials, pillows and blankets were also distributed to the Old Age Persons. The whole day, a special Meals with sweets were provided to the Old Age Persons.

The Old Age Home is running with the help of rented building. Books, Magazines and News Papers are provide to the Old Age Home. Guest Speaker has been invited to the Old Age Home for delivered good speech twice in a month. Chief Accounts Officer, District Social Welfare Officer have visited the Old Age Home and appreciated very much.
